Dr. Emily Williams Burch began teaching in 2007, including directing community choirs, teaching in public schools, training in professional development settings for QuaverEd, and at the university level. Currently Dr. Burch works as a Professor of Music in the Acting and

Sound Design departments at the Savannah College of Art and Design. Prior to that, Burch was the Coordinator of Music Education at the University of South Carolina, Aiken. Dr. Burch serves as chair of the ACDA National Standing Committee for Advocacy and Collaboration and as an at-large member of the NAFME Choral Committee. As a published author, she co-wrote "The Business of Choir" in 2022. All-State Children's Chorus Accompanist

John Morrison is an Associate Professor of Music at Fairmont State University in the Department of Humanities where he is the director and accompanist of the Collegiate Singers.

Mr. Morrison has served as the WVACDA Collegiate Honor Choir accompanist since 2015, and the WV All State Children's Chorus accompanist since 2016. He was the 2016 vocal accompanist for the Governor's School for the Arts, and has worked as a staff accompanist at the Interlochen Arts Camp in Michigan.

Mr. Morrison has served as the President of the West Virginia Music Teachers Association as well as in other WVMTA roles such as conference site coordinator and website manager. In 2020, Mr. Morrison received the WVMTA Teacher of the Year award. John is the music director and organist at the First Presbyterian Church where he directs the Chancel Choir and Cambridge Handbell Choir. John received a double Bachelor's Degree in Piano Performance and French and a Master's Degree in Piano Performance from WVU. His piano studies were with Dr. Marina Schmidt-Lupinacci, Dr. Peter Amstutz, and Dr. Christine Kefferstan.

Angela Ammerman, referred to by the Washington Post as a “music teacher prodigy,” earned degrees in Music Education from the University of Cincinnati: College-Conservatory of Music, Boston University, and her Ph.D. from George Mason University. Dr. Ammerman has dedicated much of her musical career to providing

access to quality music education for underserved populations of children including the beginnings of a strings program at a children’s home in Chiang Mai, Thailand. Dr. Ammerman is in high demand as a clinician and guest conductor and recently conducted the Utah All State Junior High Orchestra, the California All State Junior High Orchestra, Georgia All State Middle School Orchestra, and the Tennessee All State String Orchestra in 2023.

Ammerman completed her first book in 2022: *The Music Teacher’s Guide to Engaging English Language Learners* published by GIA Music, followed by *The Music Teacher’s Guide to Recruitment and Retention* in 2023. Ammerman hopes to provide greatly needed resources for music educators and is currently finishing the third book in the series: *The Music Teacher’s Guide to General Music*.

Known for a passion for recruiting future music educators, Ammerman has given countless presentations, in-services, and webinars to encourage classroom teachers to recruit for the profession. Ammerman has been honored most recently as a Yamaha 40 Under 40 Music Educator of the Year as well as the University of Tennessee at Martin’s Outstanding Advisor of the Year in 2017. Recognized by Fairfax County Public Schools as the Top Teacher in 2017 and the Virginia House of Delegates in 2016, Angela diligently works to pass along these teaching and mentorship qualities to her Music Education students. In 2016, Dr. Ammerman was named the Virginia Orchestra Director of the Year, a finalist for the Fairfax County Public Schools’ Teacher of the Year, and Washington Post Teacher of the Year.

Ammerman grew up listening to her mother teach piano lessons in her own home and attributes much of her own passion for teaching to her musical mother and her work ethic to her dad. Currently living in Virginia with her incredibly supportive husband and son, Ammerman works at George Mason University where she supervises student teachers and teaches String Methods, Lab Orchestra, and Aural Skills. Ammerman is also the Past-President of the Virginia String Teachers Association and is known for an emphasis on play-based learning, humor, a unique style, and for the creation of the first ever Future Music Educators Camp as well as her Music Education Instagram Page: @musicteachersguide. Dr. Ammerman is in awe of the resilience and dedication of school music educators across the United States and is honored to have the opportunity to work with them and their students.

DR. ANDREW TRACHSEL *All-State High School Band Conductor*

Dr. Andrew Trachsel serves as Professor of Wind Studies and Chair of the Division of Conducting and Ensembles. He is the conductor of the Wind Orchestra and teaches courses in graduate and undergraduate conducting as well as the history and repertoire of the wind band.

Trachsel has collaborated with and received critical acclaim from many leading performers and composers including Mason Bates, Denée Benton, David Biedenbender, Andrew Boss, the Canadian Brass, Chris Castellanos, Viet Cuong, Nancy Galbraith, Julie Giroux, Jennifer Jolley, Libby Larsen, John Mackey, Dave Malloy, Michael Markowski, Robert Moran, Mark Phillips, Joel Puckett, Jake Runestad, James Stephenson, Zhou Tian, Third Coast Percussion, Bramwell Tovey, Jess Langston Turner, Dana Wilson, Gregory Youtz, and Larry Zalkind. An advocate for new music, Dr. Trachsel has premiered, commissioned, or co-commissioned more than fifty new works over the past decade. He is interested in developing innovative programming through interdisciplinarity, culminating in the establishment of the Ampersand festival to explore new opportunities for authentic collaboration between the contemporary wind band and other musical genres (including jazz, rock, and electronica), other arts (including dance, film, theater, and visual art), and other disciplines.

In 2019 Trachsel was named series editor of GIA Publications' landmark Teaching Music through Performance in Band series after serving for fifteen years as the coordinator of research associates and as a contributor to eleven volumes. His transcription of Robert Moran's Points of Departure is published by Charlotte Benson Music and his critical edition of Gordon Jacob's William Byrd Suite was recorded by the North Texas Wind Symphony and released on the album Altered States. Trachsel is active internationally as a guest conductor, clinician, advocate, and recording producer, and holds professional or honorary memberships in the Recording Academy (formerly NARAS), College Band Directors National Association, National Association for Music Education, Kappa Kappa Psi National Honorary Band Fraternity, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia Music Fraternity of America, Pi Kappa Lambda National Music Honor Society, Sigma Alpha Iota International Music Fraternity, and Tau Beta Sigma National Honorary Band Sorority. He was appointed Assistant Conductor for the inaugural season of the Lone Star Wind Orchestra and now serves as the conductor of the Lone Star Youth Winds.

Prior his appointment at the University of North Texas, Trachsel served as Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Conducting at Ohio University for eleven years. He was the conductor of the Wind Symphony, music director for the "Under the Elms" Summer Concert Series, Division Chair of Conducting and Ensembles, and Assistant Director for Recruitment for the School of Music. He taught graduate and undergraduate conducting, band literature, and founded Moving with Meaning: A Conductors Workshop. He was honored with the Ohio University School of Music Distinguished Teaching Award in 2013. Trachsel also taught in the Hugh Hodgson School of Music at the University of Georgia as an assistant director of bands and postdoctoral fellow, and for four years served as a public high school band director in central Iowa.

Under his artistic direction, the Ohio University Wind Symphony performed at the College Band Directors National Association North Central Divisional Conference, the Ohio Music Education Association Annual Conference, and the Southern Ohio Performing Arts Association subscription concert series. As part of an ongoing recording project initiative, the Wind Symphony released three commercial albums on the Mark Masters label, including AMPERSAND (2019), COLOR + LIGHT (2016), and MOTHERSHIP (2013), with multiple appearances on national syndicated radio and the Grammy Entry List. In celebration of the 90th anniversary of the Ohio University Bands, the Wind Symphony, along with the Marching 110, embarked on a European Tour in May 2013, with performances in Ireland and Italy. In February 2017, the Wind Symphony made its debut at New York City's famed Carnegie Hall, with special guest appearances by the Canadian Brass and Broadway star Denée Benton.

A native of Iowa, Trachsel received a bachelor of music education degree from Drake University, a master of music and doctor of musical arts, both in conducting, from the University of North Texas, where he studied with Eugene Migliari Corporon and Dennis Fisher.

In the spring of 2022, he was honored with the O. Wayne Rollins Master Teacher Award. For over a decade, he was the Director of String Music Education

and Orchestral Activities at VanderCook College of Music in Chicago, Illinois. He has held string education positions in Georgia, Virginia, and Florida. An active clinician, adjudicator, conductor, and cellist, Eccles has served as music director and principal conductor for numerous youth orchestras. He has also served as a guest conductor for many state, county, regional, and community orchestras.

Mr. Eccles has presented education sessions at several local, state, and international conferences, including The Midwest Band and Orchestra Directors Clinic & Conference, American String Teachers Association Conference, Georgia, Texas, Ohio, Illinois, Michigan, New York, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and Florida Music Educators Conferences. Mr. Eccles is a clinician and consulting author for the Hal Leonard Corporation. Additionally, he is a featured string educator in the book, *Rehearsing the High School Orchestra*.

He holds advanced degrees in Music Education from Florida State University and University of Miami (Florida) and a Bachelor of Music and Media from Norfolk State University. His principal teachers include Elizabeth Eccles, Laurien Laufman, Ross Harbaugh, and Dr. Michael Allen.
